# LISBON - PORTO 10 DAYS | 8 GUIDED TOURS | 2 COUNTRIES

DISCOVER ONE OF EUROPE'S MOST PRISTINE DESTINATIONS — Portugal. Begin by exploring the capital city of Lisbon, then proceed to Porto at the mouth of the Douro River. The river takes you on a winding easterly course between steeply terraced vineyards, stopping at ports of call with charming town squares, colourful castles, baroque mansions and historic monasteries. See unspoiled vistas, the medieval city of Salamanca in Spain, and sample Portuguese specialties like salted cod, hearty soups and stews, and of course the area's sensational port and tawny wines.

### SET SAIL FROM \$5,495PP

DAY 1	LISBON, PORTUGAL Arrive in Lisbon and check into your hotel. Enjoy some free time to relax and explore the city.
DAY 2	LISBON, PORTUGAL A half-day tour of Lisbon, stopping at the Jerónimos Monastery, a UNESCO World Heritage site, and the Tower of Belém or visit the Maritime Museum.
3	PORTO, PORTUGAL A scenic drive to Porto, stopping for lunch in Coimbra along the way. Board your ship.
DAY <b>4</b>	RÉGUA, PORTUGAL Enjoy an excursion to Vila Real, site of the extraordinary Mateus Palace, and visit one of the area's iconic port wine— making institutions. Rejoin your ship in Pinhão for dinner.
DAY 5	BARCA D'ALVA, PORTUGAL Admire the panoramic views as you sail east along the Douro. Arrive in Barca d'Alva in the afternoon and enjoy a tour to Castelo Rodrigo, one of Portugal's 12 historic parishes.
DAY <b>6</b>	SALAMANCA, SPAIN A full-day excursion to the ancient city of Salamanca, Spain — a UNESCO World Heritage site. Explore the shops and cafés of the Plaza Mayor, then visit the Gothic House of Shells, the 13th-century Salamanca University and the New Cathedral.
DAY <b>7</b>	PINHÃO, PORTUGAL Sail west along the Douro, then disembark for a scenic drive up to the village of Favaios. Stop at one of the last traditional bakeries in the Douro River Valley, visit the local museum, then have lunch at Quinta da Avessada winery.
DAY 8	RÉGUA, PORTUGAL Visit Lamego, a small town known for its baroque Sanctuary of Our Lady of Remedies, dating back to the 14th century and still used by pilgrims today. Visit the shrine and descend the grand staircase. See the town's Gothic cathedral and the ruins of 12th-century Lamego Castle.
DAY <b>9</b>	PORTO, PORTUGAL  Take a city tour of Porto and visit a typical port wine—making facility. Later, take an optional excursion to Guimarães and its fascinating medieval quarter. Later, enjoy a festive farewell dinner.
10	PORTO, PORTUGAL After breakfast, head to the airport for your return flight. Alternatively, extend your time in the region with a two-night extension in Braga, Portugal and Santiago de Compostela, Spain.

### **FLAVOURS OF LISBON**

Get to know Lisbon's rich culture through its food during a walking tour. Stroll through the vibrant district of Graça and savour a selection of petiscos — small servings of tasty bites — and locally produced liqueur. Later, visit an authentic wine bar for more delicious samples.

### HISTORIC GUIMARÃES

Visit the nation's first capital, Guimarães, and enjoy a guided walk through the narrow streets of Old Town, a UNESCO World Heritage site. See Guimarães Castle, the Palace of the Dukes of Braganza, the charming houses in Santa Maria Street and Praca Santiago.

### **CISTERCIANS & WINES**

Your first stop is São João de Tarouca, a 12th-century monastery. With the Cistercian monks came the cultivation of the fields and vineyards in the Varosa Valley. Next, visit the Casa de Santo António Britiande in the heart of the Távora-Varosa wine region for a tasting.

### **BATALHA & FÁTIMA**

In Batalha, explore Santa Maria da Vitoria Monastery, a UNESCO World Heritage site that was built in the 14th century. Continue on to Fátima and visit the Our Lady of the Rosary shrine where the Virgin Mary is said to have appeared to three shepherd children in 1917.

### NATIONAL TILE MUSEUM

One of Portugal's most distinctive art forms is the blue and white ceramic tiles known as azulejos. Tour Lisbon's National Tile Museum, learn about the centuries-old Portuguese tile-making tradition, then make your own decorative tile to take home with you.

### PORT WINE CELLARS

Explore a renowned wine cellar in Vila Nova de Gaia and sample its famed fortified wine, port. Take a guided tour of the cellar, then enjoy a tasting of the three different varieties of port—ruby, tawny and white.


