# KOBLENZ & RÜDESHEIM, GERMANY

Disembark for a lively and informative tour of Ehrenbreitstein Fortress. Alternately, choose an optional excursion to tour the 700-year old Marksburg Castle. Enjoy an onboard lunch as you cruise the scenic Middle Rhine, a UNESCO World Heritage site, then arrive in Rüdesheim and spend free time in the pedestrian-only Drosselgasse.


#### SPEYER, GERMANY

# STRASBOURG FROM THE TOP

Begin your tour with a tram ride into the heart of the city where you'll find the towering Gothic cathedral. Admire its grand exterior, then ascend its spiral staircase for unrivalled views of Strasbourg. Next, visit the Petite France area — a UNESCO World Heritage site.

#### **ALSATIAN WINE TASTING**

Explore the treasures of Alsace, from its Renaissance beauty and distinct culture to its crisp, clean white wines. Enjoy a drive into the Alsatian wine country and stop for a winery and cellar tour and tasting. If the season permits, take a walk through the vineyards.

# TOP OF COLOGNE

Climb up to the roof of Cologne Cathedral with a local guide. Visit the restoration workshops and see the vast tower spaces and massive iron structures holding up the roof. Venture onto the roof itself for incredible, up-close views of the cathedral's Gothic architecture.

# MEDIEVAL MARKSBURG CASTLE

The incredible Marksburg Castle watches over the town as it has since the 13th century. Enjoy spectacular views of the Rhine and the surrounding countryside, tour the citadel, see the impressive kitchens in the Gothic Hall building and study the Gimbel Collection.

# KINDERDIJK BY VINTAGE BARGE

Board the Jantina, a 125-year-old restored cargo vessel, and sail to the Blokker Windmill, which dates back to 1630. Meet the miller and his family and tour the windmill — take a peek at the vegetable garden, the cooking shed and the outhouse.

# **MERCEDES-BENZ FACTORY**

Witness the precision that goes into every Mercedes. Marvel at the all-glass, futuristic visitor centre and watch as these fine cars come together along a vast and intricate assembly line. More than three million Mercedes have been built here since the plant's opening in 1992.

# DINE IN RÜDESHEIM AM RHEIN
