DAY 1	<b>TOKYO, JAPAN</b> Embark and settle into your veranda stateroom with plenty of time to explore your ship.
DAY 2	<b>TOKYO, JAPAN</b> Explore Tokyo on your own today. Perhaps visit the picturesque garden, Shinjuku Gyoen, or ride the city's famous subway to the Ginza District.

DAY 4	<b>SAPPORO, JAPAN</b> Immerse yourself in the fascinating culture of Japan's northern island. Choose to attend a geisha performance.
DAY 5	<b>SAPPORO, JAPAN</b> On your second day in Sapporo, choose to walk along picturesque Otaru Canal or take part in the time-honoured Japanese custom of hanami, or "flower-viewing".
DAY 6-7	<b>CRUISE THE SEA OF OKHOTSK</b> Sail the waters of the Sea of Okhotsk while reading a book by the Main Pool or unwind with a visit to the sauna.
DAY 8	<b>PETROPAVLOVSK-KAMCHATSKY, RUSSIA</b> Explore one of Russia's most important eastern settlements, Petropavlovsk-Kamchatsky, a cultural hub perched on the high scenic hills of the Kamchatka Peninsula.
DAY 9	<b>PETROPAVLOVSK-KAMCHATSKY, RUSSIA</b> Discover the area's natural history and heritage, visiting the rugged countryside or visiting a Koryak village to witness the daily lives of native people.
DAY 10	<b>CRUISE THE BERING SEA</b> Cross the legendary Bering Sea with a relaxing tea in the Wintergarden, or enjoy some music in the Living Room.
DAY 11	<b>CROSS THE INTERNATIONAL DATE LINE</b> As you cross the International Date Line today, you will "cruise into yesterday", gaining a day.
DAY 12	<b>CRUISE THE BERING SEA</b> Continue cruising the Bering Sea. Join an onboard lecture to learn about the upcoming Alaska ports.
DAY 13	<b>DUTCH HARBOR, UNITED STATES</b> Head ashore to explore the port on your own, absorbing island heritage in a picturesque island setting surrounded by snow-capped mountains.
DAY 14	<b>CRUISE THE GULF OF ALASKA</b> Enjoy a workout session in the Fitness Centre or authentic Norwegian fare at Mamsen's gourmet deli for lunch.
DAY 15	<b>KODIAK, UNITED STATES</b> Enjoy the compelling setting of Kodiak while learning about the city's booming fishing industry or the lives of the natives, perhaps spotting humpback whales and bears.
DAY 16	<b>SEWARD, UNITED STATES</b> Discover the humble seaport as the starting point of the world-famous Iditarod dogsled race. Explore thriving sea life right off the coast and the breathtaking glacier views.

DAY 17	<b>VALDEZ, UNITED STATES</b> Learn about the town's rich history on a walking tour or visit the superb Columbia Tidal Glacier in Prince William Sound to try your luck catching Alaska's famous salmon.
DAY 18	<b>CRUISE YAKUTAT BAY</b> Cruise into majestic Yakutat Bay to witness some of Alaska's most breathtaking and pristine glacier scenery.
DAY 19	<b>ICY STRAIT POINT, UNITED STATES</b> Celebrate the Tlingit culture during cultural presentations, join a whale-watching excursion or continue to marvel at the magnificent scenery of Glacier Bay National Park.
DAY 20	<b>SITKA, UNITED STATES</b> Explore the natural beauty of the area in numerous art galleries or venture out for inspiring views of Mt. Edgecumbe, an extinct volcano.
DAY 21	<b>KETCHIKAN, UNITED STATES</b> Discover Alaska's "first city" by following the footsteps of lumberjacks, fisherman and ladies of the night.
DAY 22	<b>SCENIC CRUISING: INSIDE PASSAGE</b> Marvel in the natural splendour of Alaska's most scenic waterways, the Inside Passage, watching out for several species of orcas, dolphins, whales, eagles and gulls.
DAY 23	<b>VANCOUVER, CANADA</b> Disembark your ship and consider extending your stay to explore Vancouver, British Columbia's cultural capital.

### TRADITIONS OF JAPAN

Appreciate the beauty of Japanese traditions with a visit to a bonsai museum and the exploration of various arts. Travel to the Shunkaen Bonsai Museum, founded by renowned bonsai artist Kunio Kobayashi. This living museum displays a collection of 2,000 bonsai-related artefacts. Later, try on a kimono, a traditional garment worn on special occasions, or practice the ancient art of calligraphy or origami.

### KODIAK ISLAND BEAR WATCHING

Venture into the rugged Alaskan wilderness to observe the hulking Kodiak brown bear. Set off by seaplane to your bear-watching destination. Depending on the season, you may fly to Katmai National Park & Preserve or along the Katmai coast. Upon arrival, head to an observation point from which you will be able to safely view the bears.

### SPENCER GLACIER & TRAIN EXCURSION

Ride the rails in a private Viking train car and take in panoramic views of Alaska's stunning Kenai Peninsula. Board your Alaska Railroad train car and gaze out of your car's large windows as you wind your way along the Placer River Valley and Spencer Glacier, an ice-age setting of soaring peaks and steep valley slopes.

### MILITARY HISTORY OF PETROPAVLOVSK-KAMCHATSKY

Explore the largest military museum in northeast Russia and visit the Cathedral of the Holy Trinity. Established in 1959 by Vice Admiral Shchedrin, it houses exhibits showcasing the history of Russia's military forces from the founding of Petropavlovsk-Kamchatsky to the present day. Continue to Petrovskaya Hill for sweeping views of the bay and a visit to the Cathedral of the Holy Trinity.

### WILDLIFE CRUISE & FIN ISLAND LODGE

Cruise the waters around Sitka in search of local wildlife en route to a delicious Alaskan feast. Keep watch for sea otters, whales, seals, brown bears and more as you head for Fin Island Lodge. Upon arrival, witness a fish filleting demonstration, then indulge in a hearty lunch of Alaskan king crab, wild salmon and prime rib.

### MISTY FJORDS OF KETCHIKAN

Fly deep into Alaska's pristine wilderness and witness some of its most spectacular scenery from the air. From your window seat, appreciate the dramatic landscape below you, crafted by nature's hand over tens of thousands of years. Misty Fjords is home to an abundance of wildlife; keep your eyes peeled for sightings of bald eagles, Sitka black-tailed deer, and brown and black bears.
