TRADITIONS OF JAPAN

Appreciate the beauty of Japanese traditions with a visit to a bonsai museum and the exploration of various arts. Travel to the Shunkaen Bonsai Museum, founded by renowned bonsai artist Kunio Kobayashi. This living museum displays a collection of 2,000 bonsai-related artefacts. Later, try on a kimono, a traditional garment worn on special occasions, or practice the ancient art of calligraphy or origami.

KODIAK ISLAND BEAR WATCHING

Venture into the rugged Alaskan wilderness to observe the hulking Kodiak brown bear. Set off by seaplane to your bear-watching destination.

Depending on the season, you may fly to Katmai National Park & Preserve or along the Katmai coast. Upon arrival, head to an observation point from which you will be able to safely view the bears.

SPENCER GLACIER & TRAIN EXCURSION

Ride the rails in a private Viking train car and take in panoramic views of Alaska's stunning Kenai Peninsula. Board your Alaska Railroad train car and gaze out of your car's large windows as you wind your way along the Placer River Valley and Spencer Glacier, an ice-age setting of soaring peaks and steep valley slopes.

MILITARY HISTORY OF PETROPAVLOVSK-KAMCHATSKY

Explore the largest military museum in northeast Russia and visit the Cathedral of the Holy Trinity. Established in 1959 by Vice Admiral Shchedrin, it houses exhibits showcasing the history of Russia's military forces from the founding of Petropavlovsk-Kamchatsky to the present day. Continue to Petrovskaya Hill for sweeping views of the bay and a visit to the Cathedral of the Holy Trinity.

WILDLIFE CRUISE & FIN ISLAND LODGE

Cruise the waters around Sitka in search of local wildlife en route to a delicious Alaskan feast. Keep watch for sea otters, whales, seals, brown bears and more as you head for Fin Island Lodge. Upon arrival, witness a fish filleting demonstration, then indulge in a hearty lunch of Alaskan king crab, wild salmon and prime rib.

MISTY FJORDS OF KETCHIKAN

Fly deep into Alaska's pristine wilderness and witness some of its most spectacular scenery from the air. From your window seat, appreciate the dramatic landscape below you, crafted by nature's hand over tens of thousands of years. Misty Fjords is home to an abundance of wildlife; keep your eyes peeled for sightings of bald eagles, Sitka black-tailed deer, and brown and black bears.


